1. The **Psychological Therapies Clinician** will possess demonstrated mental health service provision experience in assessment and the provision of focussed psychological strategies to people with a diagnosable mild, moderate or sometimes severe mental illness.
2. The **Wellbeing Worker** will work under the guidance of the Clinical Care & Coordination Clinician to provide wrap around coordinated care for people with complex, severe and persistent mental illness. The key purpose of the role is to provide regular support and care coordination to clients, to improve engagement with services and promote stabilization of symptoms. Candidates will have demonstrated knowledge of the mental health system and experience in planning, evaluation, development and implementation of programs.
3. The **Program Officer** is a diverse role and will work within FocusOne Health's Closing the Gap Riverland program, providing care coordination services to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people who have a diagnosed chronic disease. Additionally, the applicant will play a key role in the Triage team for the organisation; this role ensures that all new Mental Health and Alcohol and Other Drug referrals are prioritised according - ensuring clients access the service most appropriate to their specific need at the right time. Candidates may have experience working with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people and local community linkages, as well as experience working with people with mental health conditions.

Candidates with relevant qualifications in Social Work, Occupational Therapy, Mental Health Nursing, Registered Nursing and Registered Psychologists are encouraged to apply.
