What is the ACE Program?

The ACE program delivers accredited and non-accredited foundation skills (language, literacy and numeracy) training that reaches a broad range of people whose foundation skills are underdeveloped. ACE projects are delivered in welcoming and supportive community-based environments and are targeted to local needs; capturing the interest of participants through engaging delivery, with underpinning learning competencies from the Foundation Skills Training Package. The ACE Program makes it possible for people with significant hurdles to develop the confidence and skills to participate in learning and to navigate a path to further education or employment.

The objectives of the ACE Program are to:

- Improve the foundation skills of adult learners
- Provide opportunities for people who experience social and economic barriers to engage and thrive in learning, training and work
- Empower clients with the skills to transition to further education, training or employment.

Who Can Access the program?

Adults aged 17+ who are not currently employed or enrolled in study.

What to Expect:

ACE is an 8-10 week accredited or non-accredited group program delivered in a friendly, fun and supportive environment. ACE programs teach basic language, literacy and numeracy skills through interactive hands-on sessions such as art or cooking groups. You will meet new people, have fun and be supported to link into earning, learning or community participation opportunities.

- Language, literacy and numeracy education delivered via interactive and fun group programs
- Support to link into further earning, learning or community participation opportunities
- Client centered approach to participation
- Confidential service
- Excellent service provision from a team of supportive and skilled ACE educators
